

Photography Guidelines

Providing additional details, such as photographs of your home, can help us better determine the scope of a project, the logistics of staging and maneuvering our equipment, and provide a more precise preliminary estimate. Please know that photographs are not required, but can help expedite the process of obtaining a preliminary estimate. Below you will find a set of Guidelines that indicates the angles and images of a house that we need to see in order to assess a project. Please email or mail the photos to our office (our contact information is indicated below).

Guidelines for Photographing a Project Property:

- The approach/access to the house (front path, porch, stoop, etc.)
- ▶ The view of each side of the house (north, south, east, west) and the adjacent yard or lot
- The house foundation
- Underneath the house, including floor joists, basement, or crawl space
- The land around the house (landscaping, trees, etc.)
- ► The view from the house looking toward the destination site or temporary move site for pilings, new foundation, etc.
- The view from the destination site looking toward the house
- ► The view of the move route, if applicable
- Any and all chimneys and fireplaces
- Any additional details you believe may be helpful

We understand you may be unable to provide us with all the information outlined above. The more information you provide to us, the more accurately we may preliminarily estimate your proposed project. Final costs will only be determined after the final construction drawings and documentation are submitted and reviewed and a work authorization agreement is made.
